**Activity Title:** Food Sorter

**Description of Duties:** To keep food supplies available to distribute to families.

Check in with the Shift Coordinator, stock bread shelves as needed, check old bread for freshness and mold, sort food as it is received with priority to perishable foods, work with other volunteers to help sort & bag food as needed, keep pantry shelves filled with food which is available in the storage rooms, keep pantry shelves in order, inspect the food to be given out so that no spoiled food is distributed, keep storage rooms and sorting area clean & orderly, work with other volunteers and offer help whenever needed, store dairy and other perishable foods in a refrigerator, help the haulers bring in food from their vehicles, offer receipts to walk in donors.

Food handlers must be familiar with safe food handling practices.

**Physical Qualifications:**

This job is based on your physical abilities. We support both lighter and heavier types of work. Hand carts are available for use to move products around the building.

**Time Commitment:** 3 hours (9 am --12 am) or (12am – 3pm) one day a week minimum.
