The Housing Solutions Center determines eligibility for participating homeless prevention, shelter and housing programs at the following agencies: Share, Community Services Northwest, Columbia River Mental Health Services, Janus Youth Programs, Impact NW, Second Step Housing and The Salvation Army.

Families, couples and single females

You can call anytime from 9 am – 5 pm Monday, Wednesday and Fridays, 9 am – 7 pm on Tuesday and Thursdays, and Saturday and Sunday 9am – 12 pm;

Single males

You can call Monday, Wednesday and Friday starting at 11am – 5 pm and Tuesday and Thursday 11 am – 7 pm, Saturday and Sunday 9am – 12 pm.

Quick Facts:

St. Andrew has a bed capacity of 42 for single women, couples and families, plus 8 additional emergency family spots, for a total of 50 beds.

St. Paul has a bed capacity of 24 for single men.
